The meeting was held on 29 October 2019 under the Chairpersonship of Mrs Chithra Arumugam, IAS, Commissioner cum-Secretary, School & Mass Education (S&ME) Department in the Mahanadi Conference Hall, OSEPA Building, Bhubaneswar and the members present in the meeting are at **Annexure-I**. The Mo School officials intimated the members that proposals from schools of sixteen districts have been recommended by DLCs and received for sanction of 12th EC and release of matching grant of Rs. 26034216 (attached at Annexure IV)	a. It is unanimously decided that the project proposals received from the schools of 16 Districts through DLC for release of Matching grant of Rs. 26034216 has been approved in principle. In the meantime, MSAPS must ensure that the districts submit necessary clarification and alteration on the unclear project proposals as at Annexure V, at the earliest.



- Executive Council b. The also discussed on the matching grant request for the programme initiated at the school points by the District Cuttack Administration, and Ganjam under Mo School Abhiyan extend teaching learning materials and counselling support to Students of high schools through DREAM mission Zero F and respectively. Khimji Foundation and Aarati Steels Ltd. have contributed 15Lakh and 20 Lakh respectively for mission Zero Gurukalyanpanthi had donated 3Lakh for DREAM project.
- b. It was decided to approve the proposal of Cuttack and Ganjam Districts to extend teaching and learning material and counseling support to students from High Schools under Zero F mission and DREAM project

- c. Mo School team informed the Executive Council on the discussion held with the Rotary Eye Hospital, Cuttack on their service contribution and rendering free services to undertake eye-testing camps in Schools across the State.
- c. While approving the proposal of Rotary eye Hospital, Cuttack and expenses related to travel of team members to different location from Mo school budget, the Executive Council advised the office of MSAPS to work with DLCs on requirements of special camps for the eye camps at the school level.

3 Agenda No 4: Update on Projects

Mo School Alumni Collaboration Projects in districts

Alumni are collaborating for 11857 projects in 9426 schools of 30 districts with a project cost of Rs 100,01,96,139. During the reporting period, the Monitoring team reported that 66% schools have completed the projects and 22 % are yet to start.

 MSAPS- BritishCouncil: English Language promotion Project.

The ongoing partnership programme with British Council on communicative English which aims to develop skills of 141 teachers from 30 districts on English language proficiency, understanding and use of specific learning centered classroom approaches and techniques is being going on

c. MSAPS- Raspberry Pi Foundation:

Under this collaboration, code clubs are being established for class IX students in 30 districts headquarter schools (Zilla) Schools and 05 Schools of Bhubaneswar. Structured coding content, certificates and access to both online and offline competitions are being provided by Raspberry Pi Foundation

- A. The officials of MSAPS to take immediate steps for disbursement of fund to schools, wherever matching grant have been sanctioned but not released due to pending compliances in about 617 schools and to undertake monthly monitoring.
- B. The office of MSAPS advised to workout with British Council on its scaling up the programme to extend to more no. of schools and to prepare an analytical report on classroom effectiveness of this project.
- C. The Executive Council-MSAPS advised office of MSAPS to come up with a sustainability plan and scaling up modalities for other schools.
