The 19th meeting of the Executive Council of Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan (MSAPS) was held on 04.12.2020 at 05.30 PM in the office chamber of Principal Secretary, S & ME Department under the Chairpersonship of the Principal Secretary, S & ME Department-cum Chairperson, Executive Council, MSAPS. 		The office of MSAPS reported on the implementation status of projects sanctioned up to 15 th EC approvals. Out of the sanctioned projects, 6019 projects are reported completion, UC receipt of Rs 20,45,81,212, 7465 projects reported work in progress and 1440 projects reported work not started.	The EC advised the office of MSAPS to give the topmost priority on monitoring of the sanctioned projects. The Director, SE and Elementary Education were requested to jointly write a D.O letter to DEOs to form monitoring teams with 5-6 teachers at Dist and Block level for undertaking the project monitoring of schools, until the schools reopens. All DEOs will be requested to undertake regular reviews on the project implementation and sending the Monthly Progress Report to office of MSAPS. The Principal Secretary, S & ME Dept directed the officials of MSAPS to put up the update on the project monitoring in next DEO meetings for wider discussion. It was also decided that at the office of MSAPS, a special team comprising of one technical Assistant, 2 Helpdesk support staffs under the direct supervision of the Programme Officer(projects) will devote full time on project implementation monitoring work.





6	Finance and Administrative matters	I. Status of Fund Utilization and UC: The office of MSAPS has incurred an expenditure of Rs 393.51 lakhs and an advance of Rs. 175.21 placed to DEOs against the receipt of Rs. 997.5 in the operation account. Similarly, it has disbursed an amount of Rs 8004.41 lakhs to schools against the receipt of Rs. 8687.93 lakhs in the Matching Grant Account. Received UCs of Rs 2045.80 lakhs.	The Executive Council instructed the office of MSAPS to have virtual meetings with DEOs and ensure all pending UCs with DEOs are settled.
		II. Mobile App Annual Maintenance and Management Contract: The EC in its 15 th meeting has allowed the office of MSAPS to issue the contract to the developer after getting the technical and financial validation by E & IT department. E & IT Dept has validated a set-up fees & data migration to OSDC server for INR 500,000. It was proposed to undertake a negotiation with the developer on the maintenance fees for unlimited users and place the hardware/ server maintenance with OCAC. The EC was also requested to approve the proposal for shifting the application to OSDC server and the proposed Annual Maintenance and Management plans with the developer and OCAC.	Noted and approved.
		III. Adherence to Finance Department Circular on expenditure rationalization in the wake of economic downturn due to COVID 19: The office has temporarily reduced the support staffs from 11 nos to 9 after receiving the Finance Department Guidelines. Considering the expansion of the programmes and new guidelines on increased limit to operation cost by Finance department, the EC was requested to consider repositioning a post of Technical Assistant through outsourced agency and repositioning Documentation Officer in PMU (through the service provider)	Noted and approved
		IV. Functioning of a Helpdesk for Mo School Abhiyan: In view of the regular quarries from alumni and schools on Mo School Abhiyan and monitoring of sanctioned projects, the Executive Council was requested to approve engagement of 2 Data Entry Level support staffs(as per Finance dept agreed rate) through MSAPS's third party agency for a period of 6 months initially to run the Helpdesk and undertake calling to alumni and schools.	Noted and approved.
		V. Pilot Programme on Robotix Learning in CoE Schools: SakRobotix Lab, a robotics Start-up located IIT Bhubaneswar has submitted a proposal to admit Robotics learning as one activity under MSA which can be initiated with Alumni contribution. The EC was requested to consider inclusion of this activity for secondary students as part of 'Club Activity' under Mo School Abhiyan.	Noted and approved.
		VI. Development of a series of Alumni Talk in Video format: A series of Alumni talks in Video format from Alumni from Odisha Schools is being planned in line with 18 th EC decision. The EC was requested to approve the proposal to undertake this programme expenses under budget head: programme documentation and dissemination.	Noted and approved. It was decided to develop 20 videos on pilot basis within a month time and place before the next EC.

Shri Satyabrata Sahu, IAS, Principal Secretary to Govt. & Vice-Chairperson, Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan emphasized on the monitoring of sanctioned projects by DEOs and office of MSAPS. The Executive council lauded the efforts of districts like Gajapati, Balasore, Kalahandi, Cuttack, Nuapada and Sundargarh, for taking strong initiatives in mobilising alumni and leading the programme on such a massive scale even during the pandemic. It was decided to send appreciation letters to District Collectors of these districts and also letters to Kandhamal, Rayagada, Puri, and Sonepur for making more efforts to accelerate the programme.
