Sir,

In inviting a reference to the subject cited above, I am to submit that the 2<sup>nd</sup> Executive Council meeting of 'Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan' was held on 13<sup>th</sup> August, 2018 at OPEPA (copy of the meeting proceedings enclosed). As per the decision of the Executive Council, the project proposals received from the 8 nos. of districts i.e., Angul, Dhenkanal, Ganjam, Jagatsinghpur, Khordha, Nuapada, Sambalpur & Keonjhar amounting to Rs. 2,13,91,835/- is approved in principle. It may here be mentioned that as per the guideline of 'Mo School Abhiyan' twice the donation amount i.e., Rs.4,27,83,670/- is to be released as matching grant from the budgetary provision of Mo School Abhiyan.

In view of the above, I would request you to kindly sanction and release the matching grant amounting to Rs.4,27,83,670/- for disbursement to the 8 districts who have submitted project proposals. The sanctioned amount may be drawn and remitted to the dedicated joint account of 'Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan' (the bank details as below). Further, as decided in the Executive Council, the office of 'Mo School' will release the sanctioned amount directly to the schools from which the proposals have been received. Utilisation certificates and completion certificates from the schools/ executive agencies will be compiled and consolidated at the District Education Officer(DEO) level and submitted to the office of 'Mo School Abhiyan'.

**Proceedings of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Executive Council meeting of Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan (MSAPS) held on 13 August 2018 at Mahanadi Conference hall, OPEPA, Bhubaneswar.**

The second meeting of the Executive Council (EC) of 'Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan' was held under the Chairpersonship of Shri Pradipta Kumar Mohapatra, Principal Secretary, School & Mass Education (S & ME) Department & Chairperson, Executive Council (EC), Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan on 13.08.2018 at 12.30 pm in the Mahanadi Conference Hall, OPEPA. The members present in the meeting is in at **Annexure-I**.

Shri Bhupendra Singh Poonia, State Project Director, OPEPA & Member Secretary, 'Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan' welcomed all the members and briefed about the purpose of the meeting. He requested Mo School officials to initiate agenda wise discussion.

The Mo School officials intimated the members that eight districts have submitted project proposals which are as follows

The Principal Secretary & Chairperson of the Executive Council, Mo School Abhiyan directed Chief Operating Officer (COO), Mo School to present the detail project proposals received from the districts. The Executive Council discussed on the proposals received from the District Level Committees (DLCs) and on modalities of fund disbursement on Mo School Projects. Following are the discussions and decisions.

**1. Projects from Angul District**

The members discussed and unanimously resolved to approve all 107 projects in principle, requisitioning a matching grant of Rs 63,22,650/- as received from the District Collector, Angul. While approving all proposals received from the district,



clarification and project modification are required for 23 nos. of projects before disbursement of funds. (List of Schools and Projects are in Annexure 2)

## **2. Projects from Dhenkanal District**

The members discussed and unanimously resolved to approve 29 projects in principle requisitioning a matching grant of Rs. 59,63,574/- as received from the District Collector, Dhenkanal subject to further clarification on two projects submitted by Sardar Patel High School, Sadasivpur along with projects from Kalingapal Nodal High School on building a dining hall and SD Girl's school on beautification of school. The DLC needs to verify the two projects submitted by Sardar Patel High School at different serial nos in the submission list of the district and intimate the clarification to the office of Mo School Abhiyan.

## **3. Projects from Ganjam District**

The members discussed and unanimously resolved to approve all 270 projects in principle requisitioning a matching grant of Rs. 120,46,394/- as received from the District Collector, Ganjam. It is seen that the district has submitted project proposals in detail but needs further clarification for 30 projects (details in Annexure 2). While approving the projects in principle, the Executive Council advised the Chief Operating Officer to obtain the requisite clarification and modification for 30 projects before disbursement of fund.


## **4. Projects from Jagatsingpur District**

The members discussed and unanimously resolved to approve all 87 projects in principle requisitioning a matching grant of Rs. 46,92,822/- as received from District Collector, Jagatsingpur. It is observed that 15 proposals from the different schools (details in Annexure 2) need further clarification. While approving the projects in principle, the Executive Council advised the Chief Operating Officer to obtain the requisite clarification and modification for 15 projects before disbursement of fund.

## **5. Projects from Khordha District**

The members discussed and unanimously resolved to approve all 35 projects in principle requisitioning a matching grant of Rs. 62,56,580/- as received from District Collector, Khordha. After review of the proposals, the council agreed to ask for alternative proposals against the available fund with the following schools towards activity like subject coaching after school hours. The Executive Council agreed that schools can undertake this activity without the matching contribution from State Govt. While approving the project in principle, the Executive Council advised the Chief Operating Officer to obtain the requisite clarification and modification for projects before disbursement of fund.

- a. Govt Boys High School, Unit- 8, Bhubaneswar- Alternate project proposals for fund allocation towards subject coaching after school hours
- b. University High School, Vani Vihar, Bhubaneswar- Alternate project proposal for fund allocation towards subject coaching after school hours



The Council also discussed and accorded post facto approval for the project proposal of Unit 9 Boy's High School, Bhubaneswar with a matching contribution of Rs 20,00,000/-.

#### **6. Projects from Nuapada District**

The members discussed and unanimously resolved to approve all 29 projects in principle requisitioning a matching grant of Rs. 1518370/- as received from District Collector, Nuapada. It is seen that in PHS, Kureswar at Sl. No. 16 of the list, the schools needs to submit clarification on the detail component of the student award.

#### **7. Projects from Sambalpur District**

The members discussed and unanimously resolved to approve all 32 projects requisitioning a matching grant of Rs. 32,81,400/- as received from District Collector, Sambalpur.

#### **8. Projects from Keonjhar District**

The members discussed and unanimously resolved to approve all 26 projects requisitioning a matching grant of Rs. 27,01,880/- as received from District Collector, Keonjhar.


To reiterate, it is unanimously decided that the project proposals received from the 08 districts are approved in principle and requisition will be sent to the School & Mass Education Department for release of the matching grant to Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan. However, matching funds are to be released after receiving the required clarification and modification for projects against the unclear activities in the projects, from the DLCs.

9. **Other decisions related to project execution by schools:** In addition to the above, the following decisions are taken by the Executive Council.
- a) It is decided that the matching grant out of the 'Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan' Corpus fund should be released directly to the joint accounts opened in the schools.
  - b) The Schools need to undertake proper maintenance of case records, cash book, documents, meeting proceedings with the alumni associations/ contributors etc, for future audit and inspection purpose. Pre, during and post photographs/ visuals of the projects are also to be maintained.
  - c) Schools should submit Utilization Certificates as per the Odisha Government Financial Rules (OGFR) to the District Education Officer for countersignature and onward transmission to the office of Mo School.
  - d) Before finalization of bills for payment, completion certificate duly signed by the HM, President or Secretary of Alumni Association / individual contributor of a single project and countersigned by Block Education Officer should form part of the case record.
  - e) The District Education Officer will be the nodal officer to monitor the implementation and progress of the projects and submit a monthly progress report(MPR) to the office of the Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan.





10. **Engagement of technical persons/ agencies/ academic institutions in process Improvement, monitoring and impact Evaluation:** Looking into the urgency of developing tools for process documentation, project quality improvement and monitoring, the EC approved to organise a state level workshop involving technical agencies and experts. Once the tool is finalised, MSAPS will take steps to select technical agencies and experts to undertake this activity across the State.
11. **Building a network of Alumni Associations/ Civil Society Organisations to extend support to mobilisation activities:** It was agreed to consolidate the awareness building outcomes/ mobilisation activities through formation of Alumni Associations and constitute a forum consisting of primarily representatives from Alumni Associations of different schools who will extend support to BEOs and DEOs at Block and District level respectively. This forum will also collaborate with civil society organisations on voluntary basis for continuing the momentum of mass mobilisation and motivation for Mo School Abhiyan.  
*(Action: DEOs to facilitate formation of Block level Alumni Association representative forum. MSAPS to collaborate with INGO/NGO network, UNICEF, RTE Forum, other civil society organisations to support civil society action for Mo School mobilisation and motivation activities in districts.)*
12. **Guidelines on project development, implementation and closure:** The Principal Secretary and Chairperson, EC emphasised on following a standardised process of project development and submission by each school. The Member Secretary, MSAPS informed the Executive Council that a draft guideline has been issued on the process of project development, implementation and closure. The broad outline of draft guidelines was discussed in the meeting. It was decided that the final guidelines has to be sent immediately to the districts. Since the Mo School Programme is dynamic in nature, its problems and challenges faced during implementation will be addressed by further modification in the present guidelines, if required.  
*(Action: MSAPS to circulate the guidelines in an early date to all Collectors, DEOs and BEOs. Steps should be taken to circulate the scheme details and the guidelines to schools)*
13. **Staffing in MSAPS:**
- The recruitment of CEO and CCO through advertisement was discussed. As the CEO selection procedure is in process, it was decided to issue open advertisement at an early date once it is finalised. The CCO position will be advertised once the post gets concurrence from the Finance department.
  - It was informed that since the post of Chief Education Officer and Chief People Officer posts have been approved by the Government, it has been sent to Finance Department for concurrence. Principal Secretary and Chairperson, EC directed to undertake a follow up with the Finance




Department. The appointment of the selected persons for the above post will be done after obtaining Finance Department concurrence.

- c. Establishment of a Project Management Unit (PMU) was also discussed. It was intimated that the PMU proposal has already been submitted in S & ME Department for necessary approval.
- d. It was informed that Home department has been requested to place services of one Section Officer, One Desk Officer and one Asst Section Officer to the office of Mo School. Further it was informed that the sanctioned posts of two nos of Stenos may not be posted by Home Department in the present scenario. The Executive Council unanimously decided to engage two numbers of technical/ office assistants with higher skills through an outsourced agency already engaged by OPEPA. Taking into account the high volume of financial transaction involved in the MSAPS, Principal Secretary, S & ME Department agreed to put up a Uol note to Home Department for early posting of the sanctioned staffs.

14. **Funds for MSAPS:** Since it is observed that large scale mobilisation in the districts have taken place, it is decided that the office of Mo School should request S & ME Department to take necessary steps for budgetary allocation of an additional Rupees 30 Crores for Mo school corpus fund. Further it was intimated to the house that a budgetary provision of Rupees 9. 27 Crores for undertaking the programmes and expenditure of the office of Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan has already been submitted to S & ME department after approval in the 1<sup>st</sup> Governing Council meeting. The Principal Secretary and Chairperson, EC directed that necessary steps are to be taken by S & ME department to submit the budgetary requirement of MSAPS for approval in the supplementary budget.


The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair with a decision to have the next meeting during the last week of August 2018.
