Proceedings of the 30th meeting of the Executive Council of Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan (MSAPS) held on 30.11.2021 at 06:00 PM through virtual mode

The 30th meeting of the Executive Council of Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan (MSAPS) was held on 30.11.2021 at 06.00 PM through virtual mode under the Chairpersonship of the Principal Secretary, S & ME Department-cum Chairperson, Executive Council, MSAPS. The list of members attended the meeting is attached at **Annexure-I**.

The Member Secretary, Mo School started the meeting with a welcome note. While delivering the initial remark, Chairperson, EC and Principal Secretary, S & ME Department emphasized on the alumni mobilisation and contribution at the school level and prioritizing field monitoring to maintain transparency on the ongoing works. Chairperson also instructed the office of MSAPS to reserve Rs 30 Crores towards matching grants for the alumni funded projects for the remaining period of the financial year 2021-22. The Executive Council discussed on the presentation, and decisions taken thereof are as follows:

III. High School Transformation Programme: 1075 schools out of 1132 schools got dedicated by Hon'ble CM in the 1st phase. Schools are advised to start the aspirational components and academic enrichment programme with multi stakeholder's participation. Necessary instructions are being issued to undertake pre-project documentation of 2nd phase project schools.

Noted. The EC instructed the office of MSAPS to coordinate with Directorate of Secondary Education and organize the training programme for teachers of HT schools on "Blended Learning Methods" with support from OSEPA.

IV. HS T Programme: Remedial and elibrary: A module on remediation program, establishing state-of-the-art e-Library, leadership development and building 21st century skills is being prepared by the office of MSAPS with support from People for Action, Quest Alliance and Piramal Foundation on Education Leadership. The module preparation will be made available by 2nd week of December, 2021. The training will be rolled out in Dec 2021

Noted.

The EC directed the office of MSAPS to develop and circulate the advisory on management of elibrary to all HS T Schools.

V. 21st Century Skills for students and teachers in HT Programme: Digital Skills for Teachers: The virtual orientation of the State Resource Group was completed on 12th November 2021 in collaboration with Quest Alliance and PFEL. The virtual training on digital literacy for 2 teachers per school has already commenced from 16th November 2021 and will be completed by 11th Dec 2021.

Noted.

The EC directed the office of MSAPS to workout face to face training programme on digital skills for all teachers of HT Schools.

VI. Learning camps in community though Volunteers and Alumni in collaboration with Pratham and BGVS: In the 1st phase, the programme is launched in 1151 centres across 16 districts. In the 2nd phase, MSAPS is planning to launch in 3849 centres across 30 districts by 1st week of December 2021.

The office of the MSAPS is planning to organize an orientation programme from 1st week of Dec'21 for the selected CRCCs.

VII. Transformation of Elementary Schools in collaboration with Livonik Foundation & Tata Trust: A Teachers' workshop on High impact design solution for Elementary School was conducted on 27th & 28th October 2021 and school-wise proposals have been developed. A workshop on library management for elementary school teachers was conducted at DIET, Rayagada. The Director, SCERT has been also requested to allocate a designated space in DIET, Rayagada to establish an Academic Resource Centre.

Increasing the Upper limit of Matching grants in a year for High Schools: As per the provision in the Mo School Abhiyan Bylaw, an upper cap has been set for the release of matching grant @ Rs 50 lakh per school in each financial year and specific relaxation on case-to-case basis. Since the inception of the High School Transformation Program, selected High Schools are being provided matching grant @ Rs 30 lakh per school against the CSR contributions mobilized under the program. Due to rigorous alumni connect initiatives at the district and state level, good number of alumni contributions are also being mobilized for the school development activities. 5T High School Transformation Programme: The second phase of HT is planned in 3365 schools from November 2021 out of which 2222 schools will be funded CSR contribution and 1143 schools will be funded under DMF and OMBADC. The tentative no of schools' district wise is attached in Annexure III for EC approval.

Ongoing: In the 2nd phase, till date a total of Rs 155.8 Cr has been released to 704 no of schools of 7 districts, out of which Rs 105.6 Cr has been released as donor (CSR) contribution @ Rs 15lakh per school and Rs 50.2 Cr has been released as matching grant @ Rs 5 lakh (1st installment) per school out of the total 2222 schools to be funded through CSR contributions.

The EC approved the proposal for sanctioning of Rs 30,000/ school towards AV documentation from the CSR fund. The fund disbursement to districts will be made based on District's Collector's requisition.

Ongoing: Requisitions have been received from 20 districts and funds have been released @ Rs 30,000/- + 18% GST per school for 570 schools to the respective district accounts.

The EC advised to issue an advisory on Transparency in project execution to all District Collectors to maintain transparency in collaboration mobilization, school level tenders/record maintenance asset register, social audit process etc

Completed: A detailed advisory has been issued on Ensuring Transparency during the implementation of Mo School projects at school level to all District Collectors.

Audit of Mo School Accounts: The EC approved the Audit of District and Mo School Project Schools Account

Ongoing: In the 1st phase 3nos. of empanelled CA firms were nominated to audit 26 District accounts with 491 schools of concerned districts. Out of these the CA firms have already completed total of 13 District Accounts along with 227 nos. of School Accounts of concerned districts.

The EC is requested to allow the office of MSAPS to undertake audit of school projects, up to 30 % of each year's sanction projects, by the CA firms.
