In continuation to the same 100 schools list have been finalized and an initial round of interaction has been completed with the Head teachers and teachers in the presence of the district and block education officials. A concept note on the 100 Schools program has been designed and developed.

Plan for 100 Schools Program (March-April 22)

- 1. Interaction with Schools: Interactive sessions with the Head Teachers, Teachers, Alumni, SMC/SMDC members of the 100 selected schools to be done.
- 2. Support to Schools: Two Teacher Resource Booklets to be developed and disseminated on (i) Effective Integration of Smart Classroom, E-Library and Science Laboratory and (ii) Building Aspirations of Students. Plan aspirational programs for the students, teachers and schools.
- 3. Baseline: A baseline of the 100 schools to be completed.
- 4. Teacher Professional Development: (i) Head Teacher Professional Development Program (ii) Training of teachers on digital literacy in collaboration with partner organisations to be completed.

2D. Learning Recovery Programme: This initiative of MSAPS aims at responding to educational disruption caused by closure of the school and reaching the students across the state for addressing the learning loss occurred due to Covid-19 pandemic. The aim is to improve active learning, set up effective hybrid learning programmes, re-enroll students, catch up on lost learning and organize responses. For an effective and sustainable education recovery after the pandemic, Mo School's largest alumni network can be used as a constructive resource to combat the damage and ensure better lives for the future generation. This programme will be operational for two years and will promote community based and outside school approaches like summer camp cum catch-up programmes, remedial programmes and bridging programmes.

a. School Proposals for 2X Matching Grants from Govt:

For the 32nd EC meeting, 20 districts have submitted 1228 proposals (school level proposals and proposals received at MSAPS level). This is being put up for EC's consideration and approval of 1120 proposals from the schools located in rural areas to receive 2 X matching grants from Government. The final requisition of funds to Govt will be made after school wise verification at MSAPS level.

- b. A letter of intent for a donor contribution of Rs 16,66,000/- from Livolink Foundation is placed for approval towards school level projects (library upgradation) in 50 schools of Kandhamal, Rayagada and Kalahandi district.
- c. Modification of Project Activities in school projects: Based on the District recommendations, the office of MSAPS has allowed modification of project activities for 45 schools. The EC is requested to allow the changes as detailed in annexure 3.

The EC gave approval to 2x matching grant of Rs. 260329874 for 1228 submissions recommended by 20 District Level Committees (DLCs), proposals submitted online/ at MSAPS level as detailed at Annexure IV. The EC instructed Mo School to verify and submit the requisition to Govt.

6 Finance and Administrative Matters

A. Mo School Impact Evaluation and Visual Anthropology

PHDMA has agreed to do the impact evaluation of Mo School Program in phases, covering 1600 schools in first phase by 15.08.22 and eventually 3000 schools in second phase by 14.11.22. The cost structure would be shared by Mo School and PHDMA in a 70:30 ratio for which the latter has proposed a cost structure of Rs 1,38,20,000/-. The office of MSAPS may be allowed to undertake the impact evaluation in collaboration and with support of OSEPA.

B. Audio-Visual for Hon'ble CM's dedication of the 2nd Phase HST Program

The number of audio-visuals will be decided by the office of MSAPS based on the number of selected schools per district. The funds towards the audio-visuals will be spent from the CSR contribution received from the CSR agencies. As the dedication of the 2nd phase HST schools is planned to be done in the month of March 2022, an in-principal approval may be given to the office of MSAPS to undertake the audio-visual documentation as proposed.
