INTRODUCTION

"Mo School" campaign launched by Chief Minister Sri Naveen Patnaik aims to reach out to Odias in India and abroad, and leverage emotional connect of alumni to their alma maters, inspire community action, facilitate stakeholder participation, collaborate with various non-profits working in the area of education and child development to support schools to help children evolve into happy, healthy, wholesome individuals who can live in harmony with their environment and go on to do wonderful creative and constructive things for their community, state, nation and the planet-at-large.

Mo School provides a philanthropic platform for Alumni to contribute and catalyze a healthy, inclusive and creative environment to groom a new generation of dreamers, doers, makers, growers, artists, writers, thinkers, designers, scientists, innovators, leaders, explorers and entrepreneurs.

Funds for the implementation of the Mo School Abhiyan come primarily from two sources - contributions from Donors, and twice the amount (2x) of each such contribution provided from an initial dedicated fund of Hundred Crore Rupees created for the purpose by the government. Donors make contributions in terms of money, materials and/or services.

Mo School serves as a catalyst for connecting alumni (and others), alumni associations, teachers and communities through a collaborative partnership to improve the school infrastructure, interact, volunteer, contribute, collaborate, mentor, nurture talent in academics, sports, culture, art, science, technology and entrepreneurship.



EDUCATION SECTOR: AN OVERVIEW

In Odisha, a total of 72,21,218 students are enrolled in schools for Class I to X; out of them, 37,16,883 are boys and 35,04,335 are girls.

While 53,68,135 students are studying in government schools; 12,77,770 students are enrolled in private schools and another 5,75,313 are pursuing their studies in government-aided schools. Of the total enrolled students, 13,87,576 belong to the Scheduled Caste (SC) category, 20,58,955 students belong to Scheduled Tribe (ST) communities and 37,74,687 students belong to non-SC-ST category.

In Odisha, there are 2,84,464 teachers who take classes from grades I to X, out of which 2,07,102 are in government and government-Aided Schools.

There are a total of 67,961 schools (Class 1-10) in Odisha of which 61,163 are government/government-aided schools, and the rest 6,798 include private ones, Central government's and some unrecognised schools.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROL

All the schools in the state are under the administrative control of School & Mass Education Department, except the 1,630 schools of SC & ST Development department. There are 218 Minority and Mission Managed Primary Schools, wherein 599 teachers are receiving grant-in-aid from the government. Besides, Odia-medium schools functioning in the neighbouring states are also being provided with financial assistance from Government of Odisha.


ACADEMIC CONTROL

On the academic front, all elementary schools are under the Directorate of Teacher Education (TE) and State Council for Education Research and Training (SCERT), while the Board of Secondary Education (BSE), Odisha serves as the academic authority for all Secondary Schools. In 2016, 1,247 Higher Secondary Schools / Junior Colleges were transferred to School & Mass Education Department from Higher Education Department of which 757 are government-government-aided.



MO SCHOOL: ORGANISATIONAL DETAILS

'Mo School Abhiyan' is initiated by the state government under the School & Mass Education department, headed by a Chairperson in the rank of a Minister of State. The Principal Secretary, School and Mass Education, Government of Odisha, acts as the Chairperson of the Executive Council along with the Member Secretary & CEO of the Society who is currently the State Project Director, SamagraSikhya Abhiyan. A dedicated team of full-time professionals manage the programme at the state-level. A team of government deputed officials: Odisha Education Service (OES) officer, Odisha Taxation and Accounts Service (OTAS) officer, Section Officers and administrative support staff—work closely with the core team.



The core team coordinates with the Department of School & Mass Education (S&ME), Government of Odisha, and its wings including the SamagraSikhya Abhiyan, Odisha Adarsh Vidyalaya Sangathan and State Council for Educational Research and Training (SCERT).

GOVERNING COUNCIL

Mo School Chairperson is the head of the Governing Council (GC). Principal Secretary, School and Mass Education (S&ME) Department is the Vice-Chairperson and State Project Director, Odisha School Education Programme Authority (OSEPA) is the Member Secretary. Members of the GC include Additional Secretary S&ME, Director ST/SC Development Department, Financial Advisor S&ME, three District Collectors, Mo School Officer on Special Duty (OSD), Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Chief Operating Officer (COO) and three nominated professionals.

The GC meets at least once in three months. The proceedings and resulting action items of each meeting prepared by the CEO is submitted to the Chairperson for approval.

EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

The Mo School Executive Council (EC) manages the day-to-day affairs of the Sanghatan. It functions as the State Level Committee (SLC). Principal Secretary, School and Mass Education (S&ME) Department is the Chairperson of the EC. CEO of the Sangathan is the Co-Chair. The Officer on Special Duty (OSD) of the Sangathan is the Member Convenor of EC. Other members of the EC include COO of the Sangathan, Director-Elementary Education, Director-TE & SCERT (Teacher Education and State Council for Education Research and Training), OSEPA State Project Director (SPD), OSEPA Financial Advisor and Chief Accounts Officer, Superintending Engineer of the Public Works Department (PWD).

The nominated members include a practising architect, a renowned filmmaker, a pedagogy expert and two other distinguished professionals nominated by the CEO and/or Mo School Chairperson – including but not limited to the field of school education, arts, literature, design, advertising, science, engineering, social work and sports.

DISTRICT LEVEL COMMITTEE

Odisha has 30 districts. Each district has its own Mo School District Level Committee (DLC). The District Collector is the Chairperson of the DLC. The District Education Officer (DEO) is the Member Convenor of the DLC. The DLC includes District Project Coordinator (DPC) of SarbaSikhya Abhiyan, Principal of District Institute of Education & Training (DIET), a Block Education Officer (BEO), two citizen representatives of the School Management and Development Committee (SMDC).

The nominated members include: a practicing architect and a filmmaker nominated by the Mo School Abhiyan and two other professionals nominated by the Collector – including but not limited to the field of school education, arts, literature, design, advertising, science, engineering, social work and sports.

TE OBJECTIVES

Mo School aims to create a platform for people to connect, collaborate and contribute to revamping the government and government-aided schools in Odisha. A robust and vibrant school education system holds the key to a brighter future for the state and its people. Odisha needs to groom its school children to be successful citizens that shape the emergence of a progressive and cosmopolitan state leading it to be the most developed one in the nation. Mo School is a first-of-its-kind initiative in the country – a citizengovernment partnership in which the former leads in designing the programme, defining its goals and directing its implementation.


The overarching goal of Mo School is to: Foster and facilitate volunteerism to give back to alma mater.

- Provide a platform for individuals (including, but not limited to, alumni), associations, social impact organisations, foundations, philanthropists, companies and others to contribute to the development of the school ecosystem in Odisha.
- Leverage the experience, success and influence of the alumni and its vast worldwide network to impart best practices in school education.
- Create an enabling environment to harness the vast human resources and intellectual capital of the State and its people.
- Equip students with the physical and mental infrastructure required for multifaceted development such that they can evolve into wholesome individuals empowered to pursue any vocation, profession or avocation that they are passionate about.
- Groom school children to become dreamers, doers, makers, growers, explorers, experimenters and entrepreneurs.

DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY

The MSAPS has adopted a multipronged strategy for the development of the education sector by creating required infrastructure and facilities in the State by mobilising resources from the alumni. The contribution received in terms of funds for developing the schools, the state government will contribute double (2x) the amount. In this regard, a special corpus has been announced by the state government every Financial Year.

- Once the concerned school receives a project proposal and its budget estimate from a donor and approves it; it passes on a list of all approved projects and corresponding monetary contributions to the District Education Officer (DEO).
- The DEO submits a consolidated list of all school projects and donations from his/her district to the Mo School Executive Council for approval and the 2x matching grant from the state.
- After examining that the project(s) meet certain pre-decided criteria and standards, the Executive Council (EC) of Mo School after due deliberations gives nod to the projects.
- After receiving the matching funds from the Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan (MSAPS), the school initiates the implementation of project with an intimation to the contributor.



ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS (2019-20)

June, 2019

• The Operation Support Unit (OSU) was made fully functional and started its operation in the MSAPS Office.

July, 2019

• The 10th Executive Council Meeting was held on 18th July 2019. In the meeting, 489 school projects amounting to Rs.5,83,16,518 from 18 districts with a donor contribution of Rs.1,94,65,506 and State Govt's share of matching grant Rs.3,88,51,012 were approved.

August, 2019

December, 2019

• The fifth meeting of Governing Council (GC) held on 9th December 2019, approved the plan for implementation of a special programme with alumni on revamping 100 years and 50 years old schools, organising a special drive to connect alumni to schools for special learning camps during April-June 2020 and a Library project in 1000 schools.

January, 2020

- The 13th Executive Council meeting held on 14th January 2020, approved 1065 school projects amounting to Rs.6,22,66,260 from 21 districts with a donor contribution of Rs.2,07,55,420 and State Govt's share of matching grant Rs. 4,15,10,840. It was decided to set up a Children's Resource Centre (Library) and Reading Room in one of the schools located in Bhubaneswar in collaboration with OSEPA as a demonstration model for the state. The EC also instructed the office of MSAPS to come up with a book list for grade-specific reading materials for school libraries.
- Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan put up a stall in Adivasi Mela- 2020 held from 2nd January, 2020 to 9th February, 2020 as part of its promotional activity.

February, 2020

• The 14th Executive Council meeting held on 12th February 2020, approved 827 school projects amounting to Rs. 6,08,43,115 from 21 districts with a donor contribution of Rs. 2,69,47,705 and State Govt's share of matching grant Rs. 5,38,95,410. The EC also approved a project with Infosys Foundation for spending Rs. 5 Crore in 50 schools for various infrastructural developments under the supervision of Mo School Abhiyan and a project with the Agastya Foundation to train 753 Science and Math teachers of the state.

March, 2020

• The sixth meeting of Governing Council held on 6th March 2020 gave its approval to collaborate with Jolly Future Foundation in building a learning environment for English in the early grades.

COLLABORATIVE PROGRAMMES

Communicative English for Secondary School Students

A programme to improve communication skills in English among Class IX students and teachers was undertaken in collaboration with British Council. It was implemented in 100 Adarsha Vidyalayas, 30 Zilla High Schools and 11 High Schools of Cuttack, Puri and Bhubaneswar. A six-week-long online course called 'My English Course' was launched for the teachers. A student-interaction programme called 'Great Talk on Astrobiology- The hunt for Alien Life' by the UK based Professor Lewis Dartnell was also organised.

Improving English Literacy in Young Children

A programme for building a learning environment for the English language was agreed upon in collaboration with Jolly Future Foundation in schools of Ganjam, Nayagarh, Keonjhar districts and Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation. The programme includes intensive training for the teachers of Class 1 in Jolly Phonics methodology and supply of materials for free in the schools. The materials shared by the Jolly Phonics have been submitted to TE& SCERT for vetting. Unfortunately, the process was delayed due to the COVID-19 pandemic and is being planned for the 2020-21 academic session.

Creating coders for the future

A programme to promote digital learning in schools was undertaken in collaboration with Raspberry Pie Foundation. The objective of the programme was to develop digital skills among students and give them an opportunity to discover and save the world around them. Code Clubs have been established in 35 schools across Odisha with more than 500 students. Around 10-15 students of Classes 9 and 10 from each school participated in the Code Club activities. Teachers from the schools were also trained in Code Club activities. Online competitions among the Code Club project schools of 30 districts were organised using 'Scratch Module-2'.y- The hunt for Alien Life' by the UK based Professor Lewis Dartnell was also organised.

Community-based Learning Programme

A special drive to connect alumni with schools for Special Learning Camps in 5,000 locations of Odisha was taken up in collaboration with Pratham & Bharat Gyan Vigyan Samiti (BGVS). It was based on the 'Mo School'- designed programme called 'Beyond School' where the children of Classes 1 and 2, along with their mothers, participate in activities and enhance their skills and learning on English and Mathematics. The learning materials prepared by both the organisations were vetted by TE & SCERT in workshops.

COLLABORATIVE PROGRAMMES

As of 31st March 2020, the Mo School Abhiyan has reached 312 blocks out of the 316 in the state across the 30 districts of Odisha. 10,844 schools have received Rs. 39, 60,89,160/- as contribution to Mo School Abhiyan for 14,917 school-based projects. The amount has been complemented with a total grant of Rs. 79,10,98,321/- from the government as matching grant.

PROJECT MONITORING AND EVALUATION

ONSITE MONITORING AT SCHOOL LEVEL

1. Joint Monitoring by School & Alumni Members

MSAPS has advised all District Level Committees to constitute school level implementation groups with the following members to support the Head Teachers in effective implementation of the programme.

- Senior-most Teacher of the school
- SMC Chairperson
- Alumni Association Representative
- Student Cabinet Representative or Student Representative in SMC

The project implementation group develops recognisable indicators with budget and timeline. Contributors/ alumni get invited to monitor the progress of the projects on regular intervals and a report in this regard may be kept in the school.

2. Onsite Monitoring visits of CRCCs

All CRCCs of the state are advised to monitor the MSPAS projects in their cluster. This is part of the ongoing practice of CRCC monitoring of schools under Samagra Sikhya Abhiyan. CRCCs are asked to visit the Mo School projects in his/her cluster every month or as per the requirement, to have discussion with HM and Contributors, on the progress and send GPRS based data and images of projects to centralised server. Further, they will keep date wise school visit report in the centre.

3. Monitoring by Block Level Monitoring Team

The guideline issued by MSAPS to the districts has prescribed project monitoring by a Block level team with the following members:

- BEO-Team Leader
- One ABEO- Member
- Two Head Teachers (Secondary School)- Member

- Two Head Teachers (Elementary School)- Member
- Technical Consultant-SSA of the concerned Block-Member

The team or the team members and school authorities are to submit photographs of each phase of the project to the District Education Officer (DEO) after the visit along with a short observation report. The compilation of these reports of school visits by different block teams with photographs gets prepared by the DEOs at district level for documentation, audit and inspection purposes. The reports also get uploaded on the share drive of MSAPS by DEOs and on the MSAPS web portal monthly.

4. Monitoring Visits by Officials

The BEOs are advised to undertake at least three visits to the project schools either individually or as a team, during the starting phase, implementation phase and after completion. The DEOs or representatives of DLCs or the state officials are also advised to undertake monitoring visits on regular basis. The Operation Support Unit (OSU) is responsible for analysing the visit reports and sending the necessary instructions/recommendations to DLCs. A state-level review on the project visits/work progress is being done through video conferencing mode under the Chairpersonship of the Principal Secretary, S&ME department.

OFFSITE MONITORING BY OFFICE OF MSAPS & DLC

1. Web-based Monitoring – Mo School Dashboard

MSAPS has hired IDCOL Software Ltd for developing a web-enabled Management & Information System (MIS) for MSAPS activities. This web-based monitoring system is going to track project implementation and share progress with the donors through Mo School dashboard. The dashboard is being designed to be user friendly for the Donors/ Contributors, school authorities, BEOs, DEOs and MSAPS.

2. Random Sample Monitoring Calls to HMs and Contributors

The Operation Support Unit (OSU) of MSAPS tracks the web-based MIS and identifies the gap areas in project implementation by different schools. Every month, the OSU on a random basis makes 900 calls to HMs of project schools and contributors to take note of the progress made by schools. In most cases, these calls validate the fund release, project status and take feedback from contributors on project implementation.

3. Stakeholder Level Monitoring (Social Audit)

Mo School social audit is an audit conducted by the schools with active participation of School Management Committee, alumni or the contributors who have made contribution under the Mo School Abhiyan. The process is guided and facilitated by the respective Block Education Officers in their block. It is a public disclosure of the Mo School Project's performance as well as an essential assessment of how well the school has discharged its obligations. Social Audit is to examine whether the money was spent properly and has made difference to the school. It is done by comparing official records with actual ground realities, with the participation of the contributors/ alumni in the verification exercise and reading out the findings aloud in a public platform.
