



A, Implementation of Student Clubs and aspirational Curriculum in Secondary Schools:

Aimed at enabling optimum utilisation of student's potentials to build aspirations aligning the aspirational curriculum of the State, Student's Club programme is being designed to get introduced from academic year 2023-24.

The EC, MSAPS was requested to approve in principle no cost collaboration with the Departments and agencies to develop the materials and roll out the programme in all 5T HST schools jointly with OSEPA and SILTT.

The S & ME Dept has also sanctioned Rs. 4,74,00000/- to have the PA systems in 395 nos. of selected Govt and Fully aided Secondary Schools across the state under HST program. The EC, MSAPS was requested to approve both projects (post facto) and allow O/o MSAPS to release the fund to identified schools.
