The 41<sup>st</sup> meeting of the Executive Council of Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan (MSAPS) was held on 10.07.2023 at 12.15 PM in the Conference Room of S & ME Department, Govt of Odisha under the Chairpersonship of the Commissioner cum Secretary, S & ME Department-cum Chairperson, Executive Council, MSAPS. However, due to the difficulties in taking up schools with very poor infrastructure under HSTP, the EC may allow the office of MSAPS to request the State Government for a one-time approval of 3X matching grants to schools recommended by the District Collector cum Chairperson, DLC, Mo School. The final requisition to the state government for release of 2X/3X matching grant will be made by the office of MSAPS after the school-wise verification.</p> <p><b>2.C. Project Modification:</b> Based on the District recommendations, the office of MSAPS has allowed modification of project activities for 35 schools. The EC was requested to allow the modifications as detailed in <b>annexure 3</b> (post facto).</p>	<p>The EC gave approval to 2x matching grant of Rs. <b>72,04,39,774</b> for <b>6778</b> submissions of 22 DLCs, Online/CSR/ MSAPS level proposals as detailed at <b>Annexure IV</b>.
