In inviting reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to say that, as per the decision of 43rd Executive Council Meeting held on 12th October 2023 the project proposals were received from 26 nos of districts i.e. Angul, Balasore, Bargarh, Bhadrak, Bolangir, Boudh, Cuttack, Deogarh, Dhenkanal, Gajapati, Ganjam, Jagatsinghpur, Jajpur, Jharsuguda, Kalahandi, Kandhamal, Kendrapara, Khordha, Koraput, Mayurbhanj, Nabarangpur, Nayagarh, Puri, Rayagada, Sonepur, Sundargarh, based on donor contribution with contribution received on online, 2x matching grant amounting to Rs.10,88,00,336/- (Ten Core Eighty-Eight Lakhs Three Hundred Thirty Six) only has been approved in principal.

B. Partnership with STIR Education to strengthen the academic mentoring by Head Teachers and key education department functionaries at the District and Block levels:

The office of MSAPS has received a letter of intent from STIR Education, India to collaborate with Mo School to strengthen the academic mentoring by Head Teachers and leadership by the key education department functionaries at District and Block Level. The EC, MSAPS was requested to allow the next level of deliberation and preparation of a joint collaboration plan (non-financial) focusing on capacity building of BEOs and Head Teachers of Secondary Schools for approval of S & ME Department.

Noted. The EC advised the O/o MSAPS to organize a virtual presentation on the proposed collaboration before Chairperson, EC for a final decision.

C. Social Audit in selected 1000 composite schools covered under HST.

After the successful pilot of social audits in 317 schools (01 school in each block) and 916 schools having projects above five Lakhs. Mo School Abhiyan has planned to conduct Social Audits in selected 1000 composite schools covered under the High School Transformation program. The Mo School Social Auditors (mostly alumni contributors, local community members, SMC/Alumni Committee members, and representative of the Block Education Officer, preferably a retired Head Teacher/ABEO/CRCC selected by BEO) will conduct the social audit on the scheduled date in October-November 2023 and submit the report to the office of Mo School.

Noted and approved. The EC advised the O/o to get in touch with the Social Audit Cell of PR & DW Department for technical assistance in designing the programme.

D. Showcasing the Aspirational Components in Suravi 2023:

The O/o MSAPS is planning to have Student Bioscope and Odisha 2036 as part of the Aspirational Pavilion during Suravi 2023. A Bioscope structure with four lenses will be created. The lenses will act as entry points to different clubs. Inside the Bioscope, students will be engaged in different activities related to their respective clubs. A rotating Globe will be displayed in the middle of the pavilion showcasing before and after pictures of schools of Odisha along with the representation of future schools of Odisha. The EC was requested to approve the activities and allow the O/o MSAPS to bear specific expenditures, up to a maximum limit of 15 lakhs, which are not going to be supported by OSEPA from its organisation of events and programmes fund.

E. Promoting Communicative English in Elementary Schools: Collaboration with Tech Mahindra Foundation and Jolly Future Foundation

The Tech Mahindra Foundation has shown interest to collaborate for strengthening the Communicative English among elementary student of all schools in 5 Municipal Corporations (Bhubaneswar, Cuttack, Rourkela, Berhampur, Sambalpur),

Under Mo School Jolly Futures collaboration the O/o MSAPS is planning to organize a refresher training of all Primary School Teachers of Bhubaneswar to strengthen the programme. The EC was requested to allow Mo School to undertake the activities from its Organisation of events and programmes fund.

The EC advised to jointly work with Director, SILTT in finalizing the programme and put up in next EC.

Finance and Administrativ e Matters

A. Hiring for the position of Chief Education Officer & Chief Peoples Officer

The Govt. in S & ME Dept. have created the post of Chief Education Officer & Chief People Officer for the office of Mo School vide letter no. 25664/SME date. 29.11.18. These posts remain vacant over a long period of time. Now, Mo School is implementing no of education components including an aspirational curriculum through school club and house system in all the government and government aided schools. Therefore, there is a requirement of special skill sets and competencies to guide such kind of educational initiatives. The EC was requested to allow the office of Mo School to initiate the engagement process for the position of CEdO & CPO.

Approval of increment of remuneration professionals hired by MSAPS:

In line with the direction of S & ME department, the O/o MSAPS has followed the remuneration fixation as per the pay band fixed by the Rationalization Committee vide letter no. PT2-FIN-EAP-CMS-0001-2018 9448 Dated 22.03.2021. The rationalisation committee has also recommended for a yearly increment of remuneration @5% p.a. The EC is requested to allow O/o MSAPS to increase the remuneration of professionals those have completed 1 year of employment, as per Minutes of Finance Dept. No.PT2-FIN-EAP-CMS-0001-2018 9448 Dated 22.03.2021.

Engagement of outsourced personnel (Peon) in the office of Chairperson, Mo School

Currently, the O/o MSAPS has engaged two personnels, one peon and one sweeper though outsourced basis and engaged one peon for the O/o Chairperson, MSAPS against the approved positions of 2 peons for the O/o MSAPS and one peon for the O/o Chairperson, MSAPS. Previously one peon was engaged in the office of Chairperson, MSAPS and during the pandemic Covid19 situation O/o MSAPS surrendered one peon position in line with the Govt notification. The EC, MSAPS was requested to allow filling up the said position for the O/o Chairperson, MSAPS as per her entitlement (Parliament Notification No. 2484/PAD Date. 11.05.2018) looking into the diversified workload of Mo School.

D. Approval for shifting the non-audit school lists from Previous auditor to New Auditors

For FY 2018-19 to 2020-21, audit of Mo school fund has not been completed for 4 no. of Districts (Khordha, Cuttack, Jajpur &Ganjam) which was entrusted to earlier auditor appointed by MSAPS. The EC was requested to allow the O/o MSAPS to reassign the assignment to a newly appointed auditor.

E. Mo School Finance:

The office of MSAPS reported on the receipt of Rs.2616.04 cr. as 2X Matching Grant, Rs.2502.72 cr. as release of funds to schools and Rs. 232.20 cr. as UCs received from schools against Alumni project & HST projects.

Noted. The EC advised O/o MSAPS to submit the proposal to S & ME Department for concurrence and approval.

#### School Level Alumni Meeting on Mukhyamantri Sikhya C. Puraskar: 08 September 2023

Alumni, parents, and PRIs will be requested to visit the school and participate in a discussion on Mukhyamantri Shikhya Puraskar and future roadmap for school on 8th September. The School Headmaster will facilitate the meeting and hand over the IEC material related to Mukhyamantri Shikhya Puraskar to the alumni committee for awareness and development of the school's plan for nomination. The school will organise plantation in the school premises towards building a green environment in the schools and promote in service contribution under Mo School Abhiyan Parichalana Sangathan.

# Connecting Alumni for implementation of Aspirational Curriculum in the state.

Mo School has been entrusted to roll out and implement the Student Clubs. It is proposed to have 2-3 alumni/ parents for providing comprehensive support to each club per school, effectively covering all four clubs outlined within Odisha's aspirational curriculum. This collaborative approach aligns seamlessly with the overarching objective of the involvement of community in 5T High School Transformation Programme. The interested Alumni and parents may take the approval for this implementation from the school in their meeting resolution. Their support will be in the areas of organising school level events, sessions outside the school campus like educational trips and assisting in session delivery on Saturdays outside the classrooms.

# E. Development of Student Resource Pack for House System The EC, MSAPS allowed Mo School to develop Student Resource Pack for House System Junior and House System Senior from the Interest amount generated from the CSR Projects and submit it to the S&ME Department by end of September 2023.

#### Completed:

The meeting was held in schools as per the schedule and dissemination of IEC materials on Mukhyamantri Sikhya Puraskar was done. The participants were primarily briefed on the Alumni Award, SMC Award and Gram Panchayat Award. All the schools which were not covered under Mo School Abhiyan also organized the plantation programme on the same day.

#### On Track:

The schools are still in the process of submitting the list of interested alumni for each of the clubs. As of now, the no. of Alumni Volunteers for four clubs are as follows:

a) Jigyansa: 3026

b) Sahitya Srujani: 3011

c) Kaushali: 3026

d) Kridangan: 3020

Two workshops were organized with various organizations, selected Teachers of Government Schools and selected Teachers of Private English Medium Schools on 14th and 16th - 17th September 2023 to develop the resource pack for House System Junior and House System Senior respectively. Development of the resource pack is in progress, and it will be submitted by 3<sup>rd</sup> week of October.



#### F. Alumni Connect Programmes

#### I. Block level mobilization meets with the Alumni.

The office of Mo School has planned to conduct Block Level Alumni Meet in 198 blocks through physical and virtual mode starting 8<sup>th</sup> September to 14<sup>th</sup> November 2023. The Alumni Presidents/representatives from each school will participate in the mobilization meetings. The Alumni President will present at least one of their good works undertaken by school under the Mo School Abhiyan.

# III. School & Mentors Meeting under School Adoption Programme (between 5th & 8th Sept 2023)

The schools covered under the School Adoption Programme will invite their mentors and alumni to have a meeting to discuss the progress of the school and prepare a plan with Head Teacher for the year 2023-24. The meet will also have a briefing session from HMs on few completed projects as well as a short report on the progress of Mo School Abhiyan in the School. The mentor and alumni may consider coming up with future courses of action for schools and student's aspirational clubs.

# IV. Alumni involvement in Uniform distribution and Orientation of parents and Alumni on introduction of Student Clubs & House System

The O/o MSAPS may be allowed to organize an orientation session for parents and Alumni on the introduction of House System and involvement of alumni in distribution of House Uniform. This will help the parents and Alumni to understand various initiatives taken by the State Government for academic development of students.

#### G. Development of Aspirational Curriculum for year II

The O/o MSAPS in collaboration with technical partners will start developing the curriculum for Year II for all the four student clubs and the first draft will be shared by the 1<sup>st</sup> week of November. The final draft will be submitted by mid-December for vetting and approval by the Board of Secondary Education, Odisha. The O/o MSAPS may be
